### PERMIT

On the grounds of Art. 74(1 & 2) in conjunction with Art. 71(1) of the Act dated 06 September 2001 – The Pharmaceutical Law (Dz. U. of 2008, No. 45, Item 271 as amended),

#### CHIEF PHARMACEUTICAL INSPECTOR

Does hereby grant

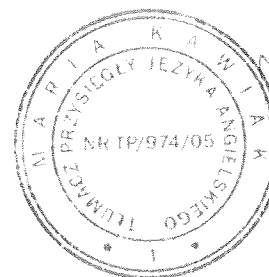
**A permit to run a pharmaceutical wholesale outlet  
situated in Mysłowice ul. Kosztowska 21**

to the following Entrepreneur:

**Valeant Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością Sp.j.  
with its registered office in Rzeszów**

**Within the scope of the wholesale of medicinal products, excluding products  
containing extra-strong substances, extra-fragrant substances,  
or caustic substances**

1. The activity defined in the Permit must be undertaken and carried on in accordance with the Act dated 06 September 2001 – The Pharmaceutical Law (Dz. U. of 2008, No. 45, Item 271 as amended) and other regulations.
2. The pharmaceutical wholesale outlet is obliged to submit quarterly reports to the President of the Office for the Registration of Medicinal Products, Medical Devices and Biocidal Products pursuant to separate regulations.
3. The Permit shall be valid for an indefinite period of time. In case the Entrepreneur does not start up the pharmaceutical wholesale outlet within 4 months following the date of granting the Permit or he does not carry on the activity covered by the Permit for at least six months, the Permit may be withdrawn – pursuant to Art. 81(2)(3) of the Act dated 06 September 2001 – The Pharmaceutical Law.

The Permit does not cover the trade within the scope defined in the Act of 29 July 2005 on Counteracting Drug Addiction (Dz. U. of 2005 No. 179, Item 1485 as amended).

**Justification:**

Pursuant to Art. 107 § 4 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, the Decision shall not be justified as it accepts the demands of the Party in full.

**Instruction**

Pursuant to Art. 127 § 3 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, the Party shall have a right to apply to the Chief Pharmaceutical Inspector for re-examination of the case within 14 days following the service of this Decision.

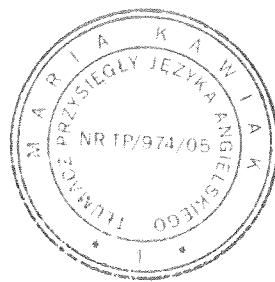
