#### Conclusions

- 1. Ms WALKER had consumed alcohol. It is possible that, at the time of the alleged incident, she could have had a blood alcohol level sufficient to cause drunkenness in a social drinker, however, for the reasons given in section 1, I am unable to give an accurate assessment of her likely blood alcohol level at the material time.
- 2. Ms WALKER had previously taken diphenhydramine. From a urine result alone, it is not possible to comment on exactly when the drug was taken, or the dose. I am unable to say whether the drug had been taken on the night in question, or less recently. I am also unable to say whether or not Ms WALKER was under the influence of diphenhydramine at the time of the incident.
